THE VISION.



MODULE THREE

LEARNING THE ART OF READING OFF AN AUTOCUE



If you have ever watched the news, *60 minutes, Dr. Phil* or anyone who presents professionally on TV, you will see the subtleties with the on-screen presentation as they read off an autocue or teleprompter.

In the third module we will show you the strategies used by professionals when using an autocue. You will never have to remember your lines again.

Here you will present a 45-second piece to camera (PTC) and see the incredible transformation from good to great. As with all the sessions, we will record your 'Introduction' and give you immediate feedback and a copy of the final product.

- Reviewing your segment for feedback.
- Goals and activity to prepare for the next week. (autocue introduction, on location or high table segment)

- Learning to read off an autocue.
- Presenting your 45 second intro as a PTC
- Voice control
- Intros and outros.
- Hair and makeup. (optional)
- Planning and developing your very own 7 min 'on location or high table bar' segment (prepared as your planning activity last week).
- Reviewing your segment for feedback.
- Goals and activity to prepare for the next week.

 (Bring along your friends and family to watch you present live for a full dress rehearsal. It's time to impress the judges).
